CHAPTER-I

KURUKSHETRA UNIVERSITY PROFILE

1.1 INTRODUCTION

Kurukshetra University is a premier institution of higher learning in India. Established in 1956 as a Sanskrit University, presently it offers education and research programmes in diverse areas of science, engineering and technology, business studies, humanities, social sciences, performing arts and sports. Located on the southern bank of famed Brahma Sarovar, the University has a sprawling green campus spread over 473 acres.

Over the past 65 years, Kurukshetra University has grown in stature and recognition of its commitment to excellence in teaching and research. The University is continuously building on its reputation of an A + grade institution accredited by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) with a score of 3.52. Retaining its position among the top ranking institutions of the country, the University has been placed at 8th position among the state universities in the Category-I by the Ministry of Education and has been awarded academic autonomy. Highly experienced and qualified faculty members, which form the backbone of the University, continuously engage in the maintenance and enhancement of student-centric learning environment through innovative pedagogy.

With a view to impart education as per latest curriculum and pedagogy, KU has started Learning Outcome Based Curriculum (LOCF) in all the on campus programmes from the session 2020-21 to enhance the knowledge, employability, skills and cultural and ethical values of our students. The University offers about 171 programs on the campus in 49 Departments/ Institutes through a highly qualified faculty. The University also has 284 affiliated colleges and institutes in 7 districts of Haryana.

If the seats after first and second counseling in **Govt./ Govt. Last cut-off date for admission is **10.11.2022**, thereafter no admission shall be made so that the academic calendar of the University is adhered to.

CHAPTER-3

PROCEDURE TO APPLY

- (1) Download Prospectus. Read it carefully to ensure your eligibility and acquaint with the requirements for submission of Online Application Form, No separate information will be sent to any candidate in this regard. Prospectus can be downloaded from the web portal for admission to **Govt./ Govt. Aided/Self Finance Scheme (SFS) Colleges affiliated to Kurukshetra University Kurukshetra Admission Portal: <https://kukadmissions.com>**
- (2) Candidates have to apply for Admissions 2022 online ONLY by accessing the web portal. Application forms other than online mode will not be accepted in any case.
- (3) Candidates are advised to upload all the relevant documents and testimonials along with their application form for ascertaining their Date of Birth, Eligibility, Category as well as for calculating the Merit for Admission Purpose. Incomplete admission forms in any form will not be considered and will be rejected.

Before starting to fill up the online application, keep ready with you the following details, and images of documents (size of image of any document should not exceed 300 kb):

- (a) A Valid Email ID (the email should be valid for at least 1 year), a valid mobile number as all information via SMS will be sent to this number.
- (b) Image of scanned photograph in jpg / jpeg format.
- (c) Image of scanned signature in jpg / jpeg format.
- (d) Personal details
- (e) Image of scanned Matriculation or equivalent examination certificate in support of the date of birth and marks.
- (f) Image of scanned 10+2 or equivalent examination certificate in support of the marks.
- (g) Image of scanned Certificate showing marks obtained and maximum marks in qualifying examination(s).
- (h) Image of scanned Certificate on the prescribed proforma for candidates belonging to SC/ BC/ EWSs/ DFF/ ESM/ DA and other categories as per the reservation policy for admissions.
- (i) Image of scanned Income Certificate of Parental Income from all sources, in case of Tuition Fee Waiver (TFW) quota and BC (A) & (B) Category candidates (if applicable).
- (j) The income certificate of Gross Annual Income issued on/ after 1.4.2022 for claiming Reservation (Where admission criteria is income based) shall only be considered for availing benefit under any reserved category.
- (k) Image of scanned Bonafide Resident Certificate as per Appendix, if applicable. Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination i.e. Graduation from a University in the State of Haryana will be deemed to be Haryana residents and will not be required to submit a certificate of bonafide resident of Haryana as per guidelines of Appendix-A.
- (l) Character Certificate as per following details:
 - (i) **Private Candidates:** Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination as private candidates should submit their character certificate duly signed by a First Class Magistrate.
 - (ii) **Candidates who have recently qualified:** Candidates who have passed/appeared in the qualifying examination in 2022 session must submit Character Certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended as per specimen given in Annexure-1.

Note:

- (i) The candidates must ensure that they have obtained the relevant certificate(s) from the appropriate competent authority approved and notified by Govt. of Haryana.
 - (ii) It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to upload all necessary documents/ certificates/ testimonials/fees with the application form. Discrepancy, if any, shall not be communicated to the candidates by the department/institute.
 - (iii) Not uploading of required documents will be considered as incomplete application form. The same will be identified and rejected for admission by the Admission Committee of the concerned institute/ college.
 - (iv) Upload the correct Photograph and Signature as the facility for correction in images will not be given.
- (4) Visit the official web portal for admission to PG Programmes Govt./ Govt. Aided/SFS Colleges affiliated to Kurukshetra University Kurukshetra Admission Portal: <https://kukadmissions.com> and follow the following procedure:
- (a) Click on 'New registration' tab.
 - (b) Fill basic details like email, mobile number, name, password etc.
 - (c) A confirmation message will be send to your registered email id / mobile number. Applicant is advised to fill up the E-mail ID carefully, failing which the registration process shall not get completed, since a verification link shall be sent to the applicant's E-mail ID and the registration process shall get completed only when the verification link is clicked upon and the E-mail ID is verified. Once the registration process is completed. A registration ID of the candidate will be generated. This registration ID will be communicated to the registered mobile and Email ID of the candidates. Candidates will ensure that their email-ID and registered mobile No. remains valid for one year from the date of application.
 - (d) Now login using user id and password.
 - (e) Fill the details in the application form carefully.
 - (f) Fill other details like education, personal, address and etc.
 - (g) Upload your passport size photograph, signature and other documents in the prescribed format as required.
 - (h) Now pay the application fee through online mode. The candidates are required to check the status of fee payment on admission portal and if the status is "OK", the candidate will be able to take the printout of Confirmation Page. In case, the fee payment status is not "OK", it means that transaction is cancelled and the amount will be refunded as per university rules after completion of admission process. The Application Processing Fee has been fixed of Rs.800/- (Rs.200/- for SC/BC/Differently Abled candidates of Haryana only). If a student applies for more than one programme, he/she will have to deposit fee of Rs. 300/- (Rs. 75/- for SC/BC/Differently Abled candidates of Haryana only) for each programme separately.
 - (i) Take a printout of the filled application form for further uses.
 - (j) For subsequent logins, candidates will be able to login directly with their user Id and password. Candidates should remember to logout at the end of their session so that the details filled by them cannot be tampered with or modified by unauthorized person.

B. Online Choice Filling & Locking

- Online choice filling & locking by the candidate can be done as per key dates mentioned in the admission schedule for Govt./ Govt. Aided/SFS Colleges affiliated to Kurukshetra University Kurukshetra.
- Candidates are advised to go through the updated list of Govt./ Govt. Aided/SFS Colleges affiliated to Kurukshetra University Kurukshetra available in the Prospectus on the Admission Portal: <https://kukadmissions.com> and should prepare a list of Colleges in order of preference in which they are interested in seeking admission.
- Candidates can fill in as much number of choices in order of preference as they wish to. Candidates are allowed to change or re-order their choices, delete earlier choices and add new choices any number of times until they lock their final choices.
- All the candidates must lock their final choices as per key dates mentioned in the admission schedule.
- Candidates will not be able to unlock their choices once they are locked.
- If candidate fail to explicitly lock their choices by the last date, their last saved choices will be automatically locked and allotment will be done on this basis.
- Candidate must take a print out of their locked choices for future reference.
- Registered candidates who do not fill choices or fail to save the same cannot be considered for admission and seat allotment.
- **Candidate who gets their name in the admission list will visit the concerned college for reporting to get their uploaded documents verified with their original documents and submit the institute fee at the institute only as prescribed by the concerned college as per their procedures.**
- **The candidates who have not been allotted seat in the first counseling or want to upgrade their earlier allotted seat can participate in the second counseling and will have to fill their choices again online as per the keydates schedule in the order of their priority of admissions. The candidate who does not fill the choices for the second counseling will not be considered for the participation in the second counseling for upgradation or new admissions.**
- The name of the admitted candidate in the first list will be automatically cancelled if upgraded in the second counseling.
- The procedure for admissions for the candidates whose name appear in the second list will remain the same for reporting in the concerned college as for the first list.
- The amount of fee to be submitted by the candidate at the institute of admission will be charged by the institute as per their norms and procedures prescribed only.
- **The candidate can check the related college information in regard to fee structure, scholarship schemes and other benefits, Hostel facilities, Academic infrastructure and other details by visiting the website of the concerned college.**

Note 1: Relaxation in eligibility condition:

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- Note: (i) The reservation of seats as per reservation policy of Haryana Government and is subject to any change/amendment by the State Government from time to time.
- (ii) Where a seat set aside for candidate from Deprived Scheduled Castes for admission in Government Educational Institutions is not filled up in academic year due to non-availability of candidate of Deprived Scheduled Castes possessing the requisite qualifications, the same shall be made available to candidate of Scheduled Castes. Reserved seats will not be carried forward to next year.
- (iii) Remaining instructions for reservation shall remain the same as already notified by the State Government from time to time.

GUIDELINES FOR RESERVATION:

1. If the reserved seat(s) of BC Block 'A' remain vacant these will be filled up from BC Block 'B' and vice versa.
2. The seats remaining vacant under various reserved categories other than SC category will be converted into General Category only if up to the date of display of final list or day of final counseling (whichever applicable), no eligible candidate belonging to the respective reserved categories is available for admission.
3. The Haryana Govt. vide Notification No.22/132/2013-1GS-III dated 22.03.2022 has intimated that as per Govt. Instruction No.22/132/2013-1GS-III dated 21.03.2014 regarding issuance of caste certificate wherein various competent authorities to verify and issue caste certificate were notified alongwith other terms & conditions and formats of the caste certificates.

The Haryana Parivar Pehchan Act, 2021, provides for the assignment of the Parivar Pehchan Number (PPN) as a unique identifier number to each family. The database, namely Family Information Data Repository (FIDR), contains PPN alongwith corresponding information generally required for determining eligibility for, or the provision of any scheme, service, subsidy or benefit provided/implemented by or on behalf of the State Govt./any Govt. Agency/Local Authority. State Govt. has been empowered under Section 8 of Act to prescribe Parivar Pehchan Number (PPN) as a requirement for the purpose of determining above mentioned eligibility or provision. The verified information linked with PPN available in Family Information Data Repository (FIDR) has now made it feasible to issue Caste Certificates over the Counter through SARAL Portal. In view of the above, Govt has issued revised instructions/guidelines in supersession of all the previous instructions issued till now, as under :-

- (a) **Portal for the issue of Caste Certificate** : The Caste Certificate (including Certificates for Scheduled Caste, Deprived Scheduled Caste, Backward Class, Other Backward Class, Tapriwas, Vimukt Jati (Denotified Tribes) , and Nomadic Tribe) shall now be issued to eligible residents of Haryana based on PPN through the SARAL portal

(<https://saralharyana.gov.in>) facsimile signed by ADC-cum-DCRIO (Additional Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Citizen Resources Information Officer) or Head of the Department/Organisation, as the case may be.

(b) **Validity of a Caste Certificate :**

1. A Caste Certificate once issued (in its standard format) shall be valid for the life time of the person so long as such caste/tribe is not removed or modified in the notifications issued by the Welfare of SC and BC Dept., Haryana.
2. Where a Caste Certificate is requested for specific use outside the context of Govt. of Haryana, it shall be issued in the format prescribed by the Govt. of India.
3. Certificates which include income and/or assets based information like creamy layer criteria shall become invalid after the validity period prescribed on the said certificate. Such certificates shall be valid for the current financial year i.e. till coming 31st March (included) from the date it has been issued.
4. A Caste Certificate may also become invalid if after due process, it has been concluded that the caste was incorrectly mentioned on the certificate or wrongly verified in the FIDR, due to any reason whatsoever.

4. As per Govt. Notification No.2/27/2019-1 GS-III dated 8.10.2020 (**Appendix-F**) and **No.22/132/2013-1GS-III dated 22.03.2022 (Appendix-G)**, the candidates claiming reservation under Scheduled Caste will submit the certificate as per **Annexure-II (1)** (Scheduled Caste Certificate) and **Annexure-II (2)** (Deprived Scheduled Caste Certificate) . Backward Class (Block 'A' & 'B') will submit the certificate on the prescribed Proforma as per **Annexure-III** and Income Certificate from the Competent Authority. Vide Notification No. 512-SW(1)2021 dated 01.12.2021 and 491-SW(1) dated 17.11.2021(**Appendix-H**) the Government of Haryana Welfare of Scheduled Castes and Backward Classes Department has specified the criteria for persons within Backward Class as Creamy Layer regarding Reservation in Services and Admissions in Educational Institution. Son(s) and daughter (s) of parents having **gross annual income of Rs.6 Lakhs or above OR possessing wealth above Rs.1 Crore for period of last three consecutive years. Income from all sources shall be clubbed to arrive at the gross annual income.**
5. **Affidavit/Undertaking by the BC and EWS Candidates:** BC (Block A&B) and EWS candidates for benefit of reservation shall also have to furnish the certificates as per proforma given in the Prospectus. In case, a candidates upload the old BC/Income Certificate or EWS Income & Asset Certificate, he/she shall furnish an affidavit on the prescribed proforma to the effect that he/she is not covered under the criteria of creamy layer (for BC Category) (**Annexure-XII**) or belongs to Economically Weaker Sections (**Annexure XIII**), which is not recognized as a Schedule Caste and Backward Classes (Block-A & B) by the Government of Haryana, as per **Annexure-II(1&2) & III**, respectively at the time of display of first/second/third/final list and so on. The said affidavit shall be furnished jointly by both father and mother of the candidate. The student shall submit BC/Income Certificate or EWS Income & Asset Certificate within

15 days from the date of display of his/her name in admission list, failing which his/her admission is liable to be cancelled.

The income certificate mentioning gross annual income issued on/after 1.4.2022 for claiming reservation/supernumerary seat/tuition fee waiver in any category (where admission criteria is income based) shall only be considered for availing benefit under any reserved category/supernumerary seat/tuition fee waiver category.

6. Only the candidates having permanent disability of not less than 40% (being otherwise fit for admission to the programme) will be considered for admission as Differently Abled. Disability certificate must be issued by the Chief Medical Officer of the concerned District. Differently Abled candidates belonging to Haryana are required to submit the certificate as per Annexure-VI (Medical certificate for Differently abled) given in the Prospectus.
7. Children and Grand-Children of Freedom Fighters of Haryana are required to submit a certificate from the concerned Deputy Commissioner of the concerned District as per **Annexure-VII**.
8. Certificate from Ex-Servicemen and their wards for Deceased or Disabled or Discharged Military/ Paramilitary Personnel, Ex-Servicemen or Ex-Personnel of Para-Military Forces as per **Annexure-VIII**.
9. Certificate from Ex-Employees and their wards for the Ex-employees of Indian Defence Services/Paramilitary Forces as per **Annexure-IX**.
10. For horizontal reservation, ESM/DFF candidates of General, SC and BC category will also have to furnish ESM/DFF certificate.
11. As per instructions of the Government of Haryana, General Administration Department, General Services-III Branch, Chandigarh containing in letter No. 22/10/2013-1GSIII dated 10.08.2017 for giving following priorities for reservations or preferences to the wards of Armed Forces personnel for admission in medical/professional/non-professional programmes running in the University Teaching Departments/ Institutes/ Affiliated/ Maintained Colleges/ Institutes :
 - (a) Priority-I : Widows/Wards of Defence personnel killed in action.
 - (b) Priority-II : Wards of disabled in action and boarded out from service.
 - (c) Priority-III : Widows/Wards of Defence personnel who died while in service with death attributable to military service.
 - (d) Priority-IV : Wards of disabled in service and boarded out with disability attributable to military service.
 - (e) Priority-V : Wards of Ex-servicemen who are in receipt of Gallantry Awards :
 - (i) Param Vir Chakra
 - (ii) Ashok Chakra
 - (iii) SarvottamYudhSeva Medal
 - (iv) MahaVir Chakra
 - (v) Kirti Chakra
 - (vi) UttamYudhSeva Medal
 - (vii) Vir Chakra
 - (viii) Shaurya Chakra
 - (ix) YudhSeva Medal
 - (x) Sena, Nau Sena, Vayu Sena Medal
 - (xi) Mention - in-Despatches
 - (f) Priority-VI : Wards of Ex-servicemen.

The Admission Committee vide its Res. No. 6 dated 14.05.2018 has resolved the above instructions of the State Govt. be implemented in all the programmes being run in the University Teaching Departments/Institutes and affiliated/ maintained Colleges.

12. In pursuance of the decision of Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court, Chandigarh dated 11.04.2013 in the LPA 98/2013 (O&M) CWP No.20359 of 2012, Sh. Ishwar Singh Vs KUK & Others, preference shall be given to ESM first before giving admission to wards against ESM reserved seats.
 13. If the number of seats in any particular category is not a round figure 0.5 above will be taken as one and less than 0.5 shall be ignored.
 14. Under Differently Abled category, at least one candidate will be admitted, even if the share is less than 0.5 seat.
 15. If a candidate of Haryana General, SC, BC and EWSs also apply for Differently Abled/ESM/ DFF category will be considered first for Haryana General, SC, BC and EWSs category.
 16. *All the eligible candidates, whether from Haryana or from reserved categories can also compete for seats allocated under All India Category.
 17. *All the eligible candidates of reserved categories shall be considered first for Haryana General category seats.
- *(Note: Allotment of seats under Clause (16) & (17) above shall be strictly as per Director General Higher Education, Haryana Letter No.12/1-2017AD(3) Dated 04.06.2018 and Principal Secretary to Govt. Haryana Welfare of Scheduled Castes and Backward Classes, Department, Chandigarh letter No.EC/2018/20179-389 dated 26.04.2018 as per **Appendix-D (1-2)**.
18. Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from a university in the State of Haryana will be deemed to be Haryana residents and will not be required to submit certificates of bonafide residents of Haryana.
 19. Differently Abled candidates will not be considered for admission to P.G. Diploma in Yoga.
 20. Admission Criteria for EWSs derived from the Government of Haryana, Notification No. 22/12/2019-1GS-III dated 25.02.2019 and even No. dated 13.03.2019 as under:

(a) Income & Assets Certificate issuing Authority:

- (i) The benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed upon production of an Income and Asset Certificate issued by a Competent Authority. The Competent Authority for EWS Income and Asset Certificate shall be Tehsildar of the area where the applicant normally resides.
- (ii) As per instructions given in Govt. of Haryana General Administration Dept. (G-III Branch) Notification No.22/12/2019-1GS-III dated 13.03.2019, Verifying Authorities for issue of EWS Certificate shall be same as prescribed for issue of resident/income certificates as specified in instruction No. 22/28/2003-3GS-III, dated 30.01.2004.
- (iii) The prescribed format for EWS Income and Asset Certificate shall be provided at **Annexure-IV**.

(b) Criteria of Income & Assets:

- (i) Persons who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservation for Scheduled Caste, Backward Classes (Block-A) and Backward Classes (Block-B) and whose family has gross annual income below Rs. 6.00 lakh (Rupees six lakh only) are to be identified as EWSs for benefit of reservation, Income shall also include income from all sources i.e. salary, agriculture, business, profession etc. for the financial year prior to the year of application.
- (ii) Also persons whose family owns or possesses any of the following assets shall be excluded from being identified as EWS, irrespective of the family income:-
 - a) 5 acres of agricultural land and above;
 - b) Residential flat of 1000 sq. ft. and above;
 - c) Residential plot of 100 sq. yards and above in notified municipalities;
 - d) Residential plot of 200 sq. yards and above in areas other than the notified municipalities;
 - e) Total immovable assets owned are valued at Rs. One Crore of more.
- (iii) The property held by a “Family” in different locations or different places/cities would be clubbed while applying the land or property holding test to determine EWS status.
- (iv) The term “Family” for this purpose will include the person who applies for benefit of reservation, his/her parents, spouse as well as children and siblings below the age of 18 years.

Note: For any other clarification, Government of Haryana, Notification No. 22/12/2019-1GS-III dated 25.02.2019 and even No. dated 13.03.2019 will be referred.

(21). Criteria for EWS in All India Category seats:

The reservation @ 10% to Economically Weaker Sections in All India Category seats (i.e. 15% of sanctioned intake) under Centre Govt. policy would be in addition to the existing reservation. Admission Criteria for EWSs derived from the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pensions Department of Personnel & Training, Government of India Notification No.36039/1/2019-Estt (Res) dated 31.01.2019 and the Director General Higher Education, Haryana, Panchkula vide their letter No.40395 DHE-190005/97/2020-UNP (STATE)-DHE dated 19.04.2021(**Appendix - E**) as under:

(a) Criteria of Income & Assets:

- (i) Persons who are not covered under the scheme of reservation for SCs, STs and OBCs and whose family has gross annual income below Rs. 8.00 lakh (Rupees eight lakh only) are to be identified as EWSs for benefit of reservation. Income shall also include income from all sources i.e. salary, agriculture, business, profession, etc. for the financial year prior to the year of application. Also persons whose family owns or possesses any of the following assets shall be excluded from being identified as EWS, irrespective of the family income :-
 - (a) 5 acres of agricultural land and above;
 - (b) Residential fiat of 1000 sq. ft. and above;
 - (c) Residential plot of 100 sq. yards and above in notified municipalities;

- (d) Residential plot of 200 sq. yards and above in areas other than the notified municipalities.
- (ii) The property held by a "Family" in different locations or different places/cities would be clubbed while applying the land or property holding test to determine EWS status.
- (iii) The term "Family" for this purpose will include the person who seeks benefit of reservation, his/her parents and siblings below the age of 18 years as also his/her spouse and children below the age of 18 years.

(b) Income and Asset Certificate Issuing Authority:

- (i) The benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed upon production of an Income and Asset Certificate issued by a Competent Authority. The Income and Asset Certificate issued by any one of the following authorities in the prescribed format as given in **Annexure-V** shall only be accepted as proof of candidate's claim as belonging to EWS:
 - (a) District Magistrate/Additional District Magistrate/Collector/Deputy Commissioner /Additional Deputy Commissioner/1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate/ Sub-Divisional Magistrate /Taluka Magistrate/ Executive Magistrate/ Extra Assistant Commissioner
 - (b) Chief Presidency Magistrate/Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Presidency Magistrate.
 - (c) Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar and
 - (d) Sub-Divisional Officer or the area where the candidate and/or his family normally resides.

Chapter -6

ADDITIONAL/SUPERNUMERARY SEATS AND NORMS FOR OUTSTANDING SPORTS PERSONS

I. In addition to the sanctioned seats, additional seats for the following categories will be as under :

(i) 02 supernumerary seats for the outstanding sports persons, over and above the sanctioned seats in PG programmes including Integrated programmes for the session 2022-23 except in the programmes regulated by the AICTE/NCTE/PCI/BCI/RCI etc.

1. NORMS, GUIDELINES & CRITERIA TO DECIDE THE MERIT FOR OUTSTANDING SPORTS PERSON FOR 2 ADDITIONAL SEATS IN P.G. COURSES INCLUDING LAW (3 YR.) & INTEGRATED COURSES

Norms For Outstanding Sports Person : Outstanding Sports Person means a person who has atleast represented the University or State in the Inter University or Senior National Level Championship or above. This include (Senior National, Federation Cup, National League, Inter Zonal National, National Games/National University Games during the course of his/her Graduate/Post Graduate studies).

Guidelines for Sports Seats

Sports Certificate for admission will only be considered, if the candidate produce the Gradation Certificate from the respective Govt. in respect of the game/sports for which the candidate claim outstanding sports person seat.

In case any state does not issue the Gradation Certificate, the following criteria will be adopted :

- a) In case of International/National participation or Position Holder, a certificate of authenticity will be required from concerned National Federation/State Association.
- b) In case of Inter University Participation or Inter University Position Holder other than Kurukshetra University, a certificate of authenticity from the Head of Sports of the concern University will be required.
- c) The game/event must be in the scheduled list of Association of Indian University Sports Calendar.
- d) The tournament must be organised by recognised Federation/Association duly affiliated with State Olympic Association/Indian Olympic Association and Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports.
- e) Achievement during the course of Graduate and Post-Graduate studies will be considered for admission in Post-Graduate courses including Law (3 Year).
- f) No sports achievement lower than the above will be considered for admission for outstanding sports person category, even if the seats remain vacant.

Criteria to decide the Merit

- a) In case of tie in the sports achievement level then the maximum number of achievements at the same level of the minimum eligibility under sports criteria will be taken into account for deciding the merit.
- b) If still there is tie, then the marks obtained in the Qualifying Exam. will be considered for deciding the merit.
- c) If still there is tie, then the age will be considered for the merit (Higher in the age will be considered for the merit).

No weightage will be given for participating/winning positions in the sports and games organised by Nehru Yuva Kendra, CBSE Nationals /Vidya Bharti Nationals /Rural Tournaments/ Panchayat Tournaments /Novaodya Nationals and invitation non-recognised tournaments/sports festivals.

- (ii) One additional seat shall be for NCC candidates who attended the R.D. Parade and Camp in all courses over and above the sanctioned seats.
- (iii) One additional seat shall be for NSS merit certificate holders who attended the R.D. Parade and Camp in all the courses over and above the sanctioned seats.
- (iv) One additional seat in each course shall be for deserving Parsi Students.

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Criteria for award of University N.S.S. Merit Certificate is as under :

1. NSS Volunteer who has completed 240 hours of regular activities in the period of two years and attended one annual 7 (Seven) days night special Camp.
2. One who has donated blood atleast twice (compulsory for boys) or has made atleast five illiterates literate (for girls only). This shall have to be certified by the Principal alongwith the names and addresses of literates or one who has done an exemplary act of courage or bravery by saving life in situation like drowning, fire, natural calamities or man made calamities and awarded at the National Level.
3. NSS volunteer who has completed First Aid & Home Nursing training and having training course certificate issued by the Red Cross Society, Haryana.

In case of NSS Volunteers from other Universities located outside Haryana, one has to become eligible by way of becoming at par with the conditions as required under Sr. No. 1, 2 and 3 of the above criteria laid down for University Merit Certificate and NSS weightage will not be allowed to the students who have only NSS participation certificate given by the College Principal.

Note : For allowing weightages to NSS and Sports, certificate should be got verified from the Officer of the concerned Department.

(G) Guidelines for Weightages :

- (1) Total weightages for the purpose of merit under **Clause-I** shall not exceed 10 marks.
- (2) Weightage for the purpose of merit under **Clause-I (E)** will be given only if the candidate has obtained required Certificates/Distinction during the course of the qualifying examination on the basis of which he is seeking admission to the course concerned. For example, if a candidate is seeking admission to M.A. course on the basis of B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. examination he/she will be given weightage, under this clause only if he/she has obtained the required Certificate during B.A., B.Sc., or B.Com. course.
- (4) Weightage/eligibility for sports/games will only be given to those sports/games which are recognized by the Association of Indian Universities.

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Note: Admission to supernumerary seats or any other additional seats (over and above the sanctioned seats) will be made by the respective college at their own level through Physical Counseling. No online counseling will be held by Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra for such seats. The concerned college will make the admissions for such seats at their own level from students who have applied for admission against supernumerary or additional seats of the concerned college.

CHAPTER-9

PREPARATION OF MERIT AND SEAT ALLOTMENT

- (a) Merit for admission to PG Programmes (except minority colleges) in **Govt. Aided/SFS Colleges affiliated to Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra** shall be determined on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination plus admissible weightages as per rules.
- (b) Weightages will be given as per rules given in Chapter-7.
- (c) For calculating the percentage of scores of B.A. by parts, the following procedure will be adopted :
 - (i) Average of percentage of marks obtained in Prabhakar, Giani or an equivalent MIL examination, in English and in one or more elective subject (if more than one subject has been cleared, the score in which he has got the highest marks would be taken into account). Prabhakar or Giani will be considered as one elective subject and reduced in respect of maximum marks.
 - (ii) For candidates, who have received their B.A. Degree after doing Shastri or an equivalent oriental titles examination, marks obtained in Shastri Examination will be considered as secured out of two subjects (elective) and calculated on the basis of the maximum number of marks in two elective subjects, after proportionately reducing them as in (a) above.
- (d) For calculating aggregate marks for admission to various courses in the case of candidates who have passed B.A., B.Sc. or B.Com.(Hons.) examination, the marks of the subject counted towards division will be taken into consideration.
- (e) In case, in any examination CGPA is given, then candidate will have to provide the conversion formula to compute % marks from CGPA (Document supporting the conversion formula from the concerned university/board should be uploaded). In absence of conversion formula, by default, the CGPA shall be multiplied by 9. In case CGPA as well as marks obtained, both are provided then CGPA shall be considered to compute percentage marks.
- (f) Tie Breaking Criteria :If two or more candidates have obtained equal marks, following procedure will be used for the preparation of merit:
 - (i) Candidate senior in age will be given first preference.
 - (ii) If tie still persists, then marks obtained in 12th will be considered.
 - (iii) If tie still persists, then marks in 10th will be considered to break the tie.
- (g) On the basis of the merit of the candidate, the seat allotment process will be carried out and Merit List of various programmes as per the schedule shall be displayed on the portal.
- (h) If a candidate is offered the seat in the subsequent list in any other programme and he/she fills the fee in that programme, it would automatically result in the forfeiture of the seat accepted by the candidate in the earlier list.

- (i) Two Merit Lists (i.e. First and Second) shall be displayed and admission will be made as per above procedure specified. If seats remain vacant in any programme, the Third List and Waiting List shall be prepared by the concerned college as per the procedure given below:

Benefit of reservation will be given to all the reserved categories upto Third List according to the reservation policy given in the **Chapter 5**. In case at the time of display of third List the reserved seats of various categories other than SC category, remain vacant and no eligible candidates of the reserved categories are available, these vacant seats will be filled up by Haryana General Category (HGC), in case no candidate of HGC is available it will be offered to the candidates of All India Category.

After display of Third List, if any seat(s) remain vacant or fall vacant due to drop out by the admitted students, the vacated seat(s) first be filled up from the candidates of respective category on merit basis from the waiting list. If no corresponding reserved category candidate is available, then it will be filled up by HGC by the Principal from the waiting list drawn from the pool of the candidates who have marked their attendance for third list. In case no candidate of HGC is available, it will be offered to the candidates of All India Category.

- (j) Seat Allotment for Admissions shall be made on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying exam plus admissible weightages as per rules. in the last examination passed as per the eligibility criteria as mentioned in the **Chapter 4** and will be on the basis of the information furnished by the candidate and documents uploaded. The candidate so allotted the seat will have to visit the respective college where the seat has been allotted to get their documents verified from the respective college. All the related process for admission including the fee submission will be done at the institute level. If at any point of time, any candidate is found to have supplied false information, certificates, documents etc. or is found to have withheld or concealed some information in his/her Application Form, he/she shall be liable to be debarred from admission to the course. If a candidate is admitted on the basis of the information submitted by him/her, which is found to be incorrect or false at a later stage, his/her admission will be cancelled and all fees and other dues paid by him/her shall be forfeited. The University/Institute may also take further action, as deemed fit, against the candidate and his/her guardian.
- (k) The allotment of the seats to candidates who do not deposit fee within the stipulated period to the allotted college will be cancelled.

CHAPTER-10

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS AT A GLANCE

1. Before filling the online Application Form the candidates are required to read the prospectus carefully.
2. No one who is already in employment (whole time or part time or in honorary capacity) shall be admitted to any of the Programme without taking leave from the employer for full academic course.
3. It will be the responsibility of the candidate to ensure eligibility for admission before applying for the Programme. If on verification at a later stage, it is found that a candidate does not fulfil the eligibility conditions, his/her candidature will be cancelled and the fee deposited by him/her shall be forfeited.
4. All the candidates must verify their personal information during online registration.
5. Locking of submitted choices is advisable, however, candidates who do not lock the choices, their last filled choice would be considered final.
6. Registered candidates who do not fill choices or fail to save the same cannot be considered for admission and seat allotment.
7. Candidates must take print-out of their online Application Form along with their locked choices.
8. The outcome of rounds of counseling, as per admission schedule will be displayed on Admission Portal. No individual allotment letter will be sent to the candidates. They will have to download by applying Registration and password allotted to them and contact the allotted college.
9. Candidate seeking admission in self financing institutions are advised to ensure that they are lawfully admitted failing which, they shall not be authenticated and registered by Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra and they themselves shall be responsible for any such lapse.
10. All the rules and regulations for the submission of migration certificates by the candidates who have passed the qualifying examinations from other Universities will be applicable as per the rules of K.U. University.
11. In case, a candidate after having deposited required fee for admission to any programme decides to leave the course, the fee deposited by the candidate will be refundable to him/her as per **Chapter 13**.
12. In case of ambiguity about any rule, the interpretation of the same by the University shall be final.
13. All legal disputes relating to admission to PG Programmes in Govt. Aided/ SFS Colleges affiliated to Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra will be subject to Courts having jurisdiction at Kurukshetra.
14. The number of colleges/sanctioned seats may increase or decrease based upon the approval and affiliation from the University.
15. Candidates are advised to consult the updated list of colleges in the Prospectus before filling their choice as intake in various institutes subject to change by the competent

authority in view of pending writs/appeals in courts/affiliating bodies with regard to their recognition.

16. The attendance rules of the college concerned will be applicable on the students.
17. The participating Colleges will ensure that all the admissions will be made only on the basis of the recognized and valid degree (s)/certificate (s) issued by the approved and recognized boards/Institutes/Universities. In case any clarification of equivalence/recognition of qualifying degree/certificate/Institute/Board/University is required, the same may be obtained from the affiliating university concerned.
18. All the updated latest information/notices/changes/modifications will be displayed on the admission portal. The candidates are required to visit the admission portal regularly to obtain the latest information.
20. Self declaration will be submitted by the candidate/by the respective parents/guardian at the time of admission. **(as per Annexure-X & XI)**

OTHER IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

- (1) The Kurukshetra University can make use of the data generated, for the purpose of research and analysis.
- (2) KUK does not take any responsibility for the candidates not being able to submit their Application Forms by the last date and time on account of any reason beyond the control of the KUK. Candidates can check their fee status after login to their account and can download/print the receipt.
- (3) The Responsibility for any wrong/irregular admission or admission allowed on the basis of fake certificate, in contravention of the Ordinance, if any, will rest entirely with the college concerned, admission of such students may be treated as cancelled ab-initio. In case any student files civil suit in any Judicial Court against the orders declaring him/her ineligible, the said civil suit is required to be defended by the college concerned.
- (4) Nothing contained in this prospectus should be construed to convey sanction or be cited as an authority for which University Regulations in Calendars Vol. I, II and the relevant rules in Calendar Vol. III alone are applicable.
- (5) If the concerned authorities are not satisfied with the character/past behavior/antecedents of a candidate, they may refuse to admit him/her to any programme of study in the College in order to ensure academic standards, discipline and peaceful atmosphere in the university.

CHAPTER - 12

CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING

Ragging in educational institutions is banned and anyone found guilty of ragging and/or abetting ragging, whether actively or passively, or being a part of a conspiracy to promote ragging, is liable to be punished in accordance with the UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 and “The Haryana Prohibition of Ragging in Educational Institution Ordinance, 2012” as well as under the provisions of any penal law for the time being in force.

Candidates are required to submit the following two undertakings to ensure that they shall not be indulge in ragging (above type of activities). Undertaking by the Student (**Annexure-IX**)
Undertaking by Parents/Guardian (**Annexure-X**)

CHAPTER-13

RULES FOR REFUND OF FEE

REFUND OF FEE: If a candidate withdraws from the course/programme in which he/she was admitted in the affiliated Colleges, the fee to the candidate will be refunded as per following rules for the session 2022-23 :

As per the guidelines regarding fee refund policy 2022-23 issued by the UGC vide D.O. letter No. D.O.No.2-71/2022(CPP-II) dated 02.08.2022 fees will be refunded as under :

“In view above, and in order to avoid financial hardships being faced by parents, it has been decided by UGC that full refund of fees should be made by the higher educational institutions on account of all cancellations of admissions/migrations of students **up to October 31, 2022 for the academic session 2022- 2023 as a special case.** It is made clear that the entire fee, including all charges, should be refunded (i.e., there should be zero cancellation charges) on account of cancellations/migrations up to **October 31, 2022.** Thereafter, on cancellation/ withdrawal of admissions up to **December 31, 2022,** the entire fee collected from a student should be refunded in full after deducting not **more than Rs.1000/- as processing fee.”**

Note :

- (i) In the programmes, which are also governed by AICTE rules, application of refund of fee will be accepted as per instructions of the HSTES.
- (ii) The candidate has to apply for refund of fee in the concerned college.

APPENDIX-A

GUIDELINES REGARDING BONAFIDE RESIDENTS OF HARYANA

Instructions regarding Bonafide Residents of Haryana issued vide letter No.62/17/95-6 GSI dated 3rd October, 1996, No.62/32/2000-6GSI dated 23rd May, 2003, No.62/27/2003-6GSI dated 29th July, 2003 and No.62/62/2011-6GSI dated 17th January, 2012 by the Chief Secretary to Government, Haryana.

1. I am directed to invite your attention to Haryana Govt. letters noted in the margin on the subject noted above vide which the instructions were issued regarding simplification of procedure for obtaining the certificate of Domicile for the purpose of admission to educational institution (including technical/ medical institution). The matter has been reconsidered in the light of judgment delivered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Dr. Pradeep Jain vs. Union of India and others reported as AIR 1984-SC-1421, wherein it has been held that instead of the word 'Domicile' the word 'Resident' be used in the instructions issued by the State Government and it has been decided to revise the Government instructions. Henceforth, the following categories of persons would be eligible for the grant of Resident Certificate:-
 - (i) Candidates, who have passed the examination qualifying there for selection in an institution from a school/college in Haryana.
 - (ii) Children/Wards (if parents are not living)/Dependents : -
 - (a) of the regular employees of Haryana State posted in or outside Haryana State or working on deputation;
 - (b) of the regular employees of the statutory bodies/corporations established by or under an act of the State of Haryana who are posted in Chandigarh or in Haryana or outside Haryana.
 - (c) of the regular employees of the Government of India posted in Chandigarh or in Haryana in connection with the affairs of the Haryana Government;
 - (iii) Children/wards (if parents not living)/dependents of persons who after retirement have permanently settled in Haryana and draw their pensions from the treasuries situated in the State of Haryana.
 - (iv) Children/wards (if parents are not living)/dependents of pensioners of Haryana Government irrespective of the fact that the original home of the retiree is in a state other than Haryana or he has settled after retirement in or outside Haryana;
 - (v) Children/Wards (if parents are not living)/dependents of persons, who have permanent home in Haryana and include persons who have been residing in Haryana for a period of not less than 15 years or who have permanent home in Haryana but on account of their occupation they are living outside Haryana;
 - (vi) The wives of such persons who are bonafide residents of Haryana irrespective of the fact that they had belonged to any other State before marriage;
 - (vii) Persons who were born in Haryana and produce a certificate to that effect; provided that the parents/guardians (if parents are not living) of persons belonging to any one of the above mentioned categories are:
 - (a) Citizen of India;

- (b) Produce an affidavit to the effect that they or their children/wards (if parents are not living)/dependents have not obtained the benefit of Resident in any other State.
 - (viii) Children & Wards of the accredited journalists residing at Chandigarh and recognised by Govt. of Haryana.
2. All candidates claiming to be bonafide residents of Haryana should produce a Haryana Resident Certificate signed by the District Magistrate/General Assistant to Deputy Commissioner or Sub-Divisional Officer (Civil) of the District/Sub-Divisions/Tehsildars of Revenue to which the candidates belong. Resident Certificates in respect of elsewhere or in respect of the Children/ Wards/Dependents of Haryana Govt. employees who are posted at Chandigarh, Delhi or elsewhere or in respect of Children/Wards/Dependents of pensioners of Haryana Govt. or in respect of the Children/ Wards/Department of the employees of the Government of India posted at Chandigarh or in Haryana in connection with the affairs of Haryana Government, or in respect of Children/Wards/Dependents of the employees and retirees of the Statutory Bodies/Corporations of Haryana established by or under an Act of the State of Haryana or a Central Act and located at Chandigarh, Haryana or outside Haryana, should be by their respective Heads of Departments.
3. Candidates seeking admission in educational institutions (including medical and technical institutions) located in Haryana, may not be required to produce Resident Certificate, if they have passed the examination from a school/college situated in Haryana. For this purpose, a certificate of the Principal/ Headmaster from concerned institution where the children/wards studied last should be considered sufficient. The Principal/Headmaster of the institution shall be competent to issue such certificate, which should be sufficient.
4. If a candidate is admitted on the basis of claim that he belongs to the State of Haryana but at any subsequent time is discovered that his claim was false, the student shall be removed from the institution, all fees and other dues paid up to the date of such removal shall be confiscated. The Principal/Headmaster may take such other action against the student and his/her parents/guardians as he may deem proper in the circumstances of any particular case.
5. The children/wards/dependents of the employees of Punjab & Haryana High Court, who are discharging their duties in connection with the affairs of the State of Haryana and have not availed facility from their parent State, the State of Punjab and U.T. Administration Chandigarh, would also be eligible for grant of Resident Certificate of the State of Haryana only for the purpose of admission in academic/technical/ medical institutions of the State of Haryana. However, in that case the employees of the Punjab & Haryana High Court shall be entitled to draw this benefit at one place/State only. Head of the Department of the Punjab & Haryana High Court would be competent to issue such a certificate.



I am directed to invite your kind attention to the State Government instruction no. 22/88/96-3GS-III dated 25.06.1997 wherein it is observed that the Scheduled Castes/Backward Classes candidates who get selected in Govt. job in the open competition on the basis of general merit (without availing any relaxation of age etc.) will have to be counted against general seats as they are open competition candidates. They will not be considered against reserved seats. However, such candidates should fulfill conditions of eligibility regarding age etc. as are meant for the General category candidates.

Hence, this department being a Nodal agency of the Government for implementation of the reservation policy issue this clarification that Government Department must follow the above instruction dated 25.06.1997. These instructions were issued in connection with the reservation policy pertaining to Govt. job. On the same analogy ; the Scheduled Castes/Backward Classes candidates who get selected/admitted in Educational/Professional/Technical Institution and Universities in the open competition on the basis of their own merit, they will not be counted against the quota reserved for Scheduled Castes/Backward Classes, rather they will be treated as open competition candidates. Cases where a reserved category candidate avail relaxation say in age, qualifying norms etc. then he/she will be treated against reserve category.

This may please be brought to the notice of all concerned for strict compliance in letter and spirit.

I am directed to invite your attention to Haryana Government Notification bearing No. Leg.15/2020, dated 15.05.2020 vide which an Act namely, the Haryana Scheduled Castes (Reservation in Admission in Government Educational Institution) Act, 2020 was enacted by the State Government. In this Act under Section 3 and 6 following provisions have been made:-

Section 3. (1) Twenty per cent seats shall be reserved for the members of the Scheduled Castes while making admission in Government educational institutions.


(2) Fifty per cent of the twenty percent seats reserved for Scheduled Castes for admission in any government educational institution shall be set aside for candidates belonging to the Deprived Scheduled Caste as enumerated in the Annexure.

Section 6. A person belonging to the Deprived Scheduled Castes shall, for the purposes of section 3, support his candidature by a certificate of caste indentification issued by the ecompetent authority under sub-section (2) of section 5.

2. In this Act, 36 Castes were included in the list of Deprived Scheduled Castes at Annexure to this Act. For proper implementation of this Act, all the authorities competent to issue Caste Certificate are directed to mention clearly that the Certificate is of 'Deprived Scheduled Caste' or 'Scheduled Caste' so that at the time of admission the Institutions may find out easily as to how many candidates applied


for admission and how many have been given admission under 'Deprived Scheduled Caste' category.

Subject: Regarding the issue of Caste Certificates (including certificates for Scheduled Caste, Deprived Scheduled Caste, Backward Class, Other Backward Class, Tapriwas, Vimukat Jati, and Nomadic Tribe) through SARAL portal.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to invite your attention to Government instruction No. 22/132/2013-1GS-III dated 21.03.2014 regarding issuance of caste certificate wherein various competent authorities to verify and issue caste certificates were notified along with other terms & conditions and formats of the caste certificates.

2. **The Haryana Parivar Pehchan Act, 2021**, provides for the assignment of the Parivar Pehchan Number (PPN) as a unique identifier number to each family. The database, namely Family Information Data Repository (FIDR), contains PPN along with corresponding information generally required for determining eligibility for, or the provision of any scheme, service, subsidy or benefit provided/implemented by or on behalf of the State Government/any Government agency/local authority. State Government has been empowered under section 8 of the Act to prescribe Parivar Pehchan Number (PPN) as a requirement for the purpose of determining above mentioned eligibility or provision. The verified information linked with PPN available in Family Information Data Repository (FIDR) has now made it feasible to issue Caste Certificates over the counter through the SARAL portal.

3. In view of the above, Government has decided to issue revised instructions/guidelines in supersession of all the previous instructions issued till now, as under:-

(I) Portal for the issue of Caste Certificate.—

The Caste Certificate shall now be issued to eligible residents of Haryana based on PPN through the SARAL portal (<https://saralharyana.gov.in/>) facsimile signed by ADC-cum-DCRIO (Additional Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Citizen Resources Information Officer) or Head of the Department/Organisation, as the case may be. These caste certificates shall include :-

- a) Scheduled Caste certificate
- b) Deprived Scheduled Caste certificate
- c) Backward Class certificate
- d) Other Backward Class certificate
- e) Tapriwas Caste certificate
- f) Vimukt Jati (Denotified Tribes) certificate
- g) Nomadic Tribes certificate

These certificates will be issued on the basis of verified data on caste and income contained in the FIDR. The Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) for issuing Caste Certificates along with the formats of Caste Certificates shall be issued by the Citizen Resources Information Department.

(ii) Person who is entitled to obtain a Caste Certificate.—

Following persons are entitled to obtain a Caste Certificate :-

- (a) A person who is a resident of State of Haryana by birth; or
- (b) A male person (including his children) who is an employee in the service of Haryana Government or any of its Boards/ Corporations/ Statutory Authorities/ Universities etc. provided he belongs to any of the notified castes/tribes by birth; and
- (c) A female person who is an employee in the service of Haryana Government or any of its Boards/ Corporations/ Statutory Authorities/ Universities etc. provided she belongs to any of the notified castes/tribes by birth.

Note.— A child born at a place outside Haryana shall also be eligible to obtain caste certificate from Haryana provided his father has been issued Caste Certificate by the competent authority as per provision in the instructions of Haryana Government. However, a child born in Haryana State shall not be eligible to get caste certificate on basis of birth-place/birth certificate of Haryana, if his father has been issued Caste Certificate by a State other than Haryana.

(iii) Caste Certificate in cases of Migration.—

Where a person migrates from one State to another, he can claim to belong to a notified caste only in relation to the State to which he originally belonged and not in respect of the State to which he has migrated.

(iv) Caste Certificate to person who claims through Marriage.—

No person who is not a member of a notified caste/tribe by birth will be deemed to be a member of that notified caste/tribe merely because he or she had married a person belonging to that notified caste/tribe. On the other hand a person who is a member of a notified caste/tribe will continue to be a member of that notified caste/tribe even after his or her marriage with a person who does not belong to a notified caste/tribe.

(v) **Caste Certificate In case of Adoption of child.—**

Great care has to be exercised in dealing with cases where a person claims to be a member of a notified caste/tribe on the ground that he/she has been adopted by a person of that notified caste/tribe. The validity of the adoption has to be clearly established before any caste certificate can be given. It is for the party to prove his/her claim by cogent and reliable evidence:

- (a) While deciding whether an adoption is valid, the certificate issuing authority should satisfy himself that all the requirements of law have been complied with. He should also take into account the behaviour of the child after adoption whether he physically lives with and is supported by his adoptive parents and receives no financial help from his original parents. In case these conditions are not satisfied, the certificate should be refused.
- (b) In addition, it should be verified that all other conditions for a valid adoption, including the physical transfer of the adopted person to the family of the adoptive parents and that he has severed all ties with the original parents are fulfilled.
- (c) Further, in case of a person who is a Hindu, Buddhist or Sikh or any other person governed by the Hindu Adoptions and Maintenance Act, 1956 (78 of 1956), the requirements of valid adoption are given in Sections 6 to 11 of the Hindu Adoptions and Maintenance Act, 1956 (78 of 1956) as amended from time to time. The actual giving and taking of the child in adoption is a mandatory requirement and thereafter the adopted child is deemed to be the child of his or her adoptive father or mother for all purposes and the child severs all ties with the family of his or her birth. Ordinarily, no child who has attained the age of 15 years or who is married can be given in adoption unless there is a custom or usage applicable to the parties.
- (d) Where the case relates to an adoption in case of a Hindu, Buddhist or Sikh or any other person governed by the Hindu Adoptions and Maintenance Act, 1956 (78 of 1956), who is married or of the age of 15 years and above, the certificate shall be required to be given by the District Magistrate who shall, after making due enquiries as to the validity of the adoption and as to whether such adoption is permitted by a custom or usage applicable to the parties, make an endorsement to that effect on the certificate. Such custom or usage should have been continuously and uniformly observed for a long time and obtained the force of law among the Hindus of that particular area, or that community, group or family provided that the custom or usage is certain and not unreasonable or opposed to public policy and in the case of custom or

usage in respect of a particular family, that the custom or usage has not been discontinued.

(vi) Caste Certificate in case of Conversion and Reconversion of religion by a Scheduled Caste person.—

- (a) Where a Scheduled Caste person gets converted to a religion other than Hinduism or Sikhism or Buddhism and then reconverts himself back to Hinduism or Sikhism or Buddhism, he will be deemed to have reverted to his original Scheduled Caste, if he is accepted by the members of that particular caste as one among them.
- (b) In the case of a descendant of a Scheduled Caste convert, the mere fact of conversion to Hinduism or Sikhism or Buddhism will not be sufficient to entitle him to be regarded as a member of the Scheduled Caste to which his forefathers belonged. It will have to be established that such a convert has been accepted by the members of the caste claimed as one among themselves and has thus become a member of that caste.

(vii) Determination/Verification of Caste of a person.—

The determination/verification of the caste of a person shall be done strictly in accordance with the notifications of the Government of India in case of Scheduled Castes and Other Backward Classes; and in accordance with notifications of the Welfare of Scheduled Castes and Backward Classes Department, Haryana in case of Deprived Scheduled Castes, Backward Classes, De-notified Tribes (Vimukt Jatis and Tapriwas Jatis) and Nomadic Tribes.

(viii) Verification when a person claims of Caste by birth.—

Where a person claims to belong to a Scheduled Caste, Deprived Scheduled Caste, Other Backward Class, Backward Class, De-notified Tribe (Vimukt Jatis and Tapriwas Jatis) or Nomadic Tribe by birth, it should be verified :

- (i) That the person and his/her parents actually belong to the community claimed;
- (ii) That this community is included in the Presidential Orders specifying the Scheduled Castes in relation to the concerned State; or is notified as Other Backward Class by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India; or notified as Deprived Scheduled Caste, Backward Class, De-notified Tribe (Vimukt Jatis and Tapriwas Jatis) or Nomadic Tribe by the Government of Haryana.
- (iii) That the person belongs to that State in respect of which the community has been scheduled/notified.

- (vi) If the person claims to be a Scheduled Caste or Deprived Scheduled Caste, he should profess Hinduism or Sikhism or Buddhism religion.
- (v) A person claiming to belong to a Backward Class, Other Backward Class, De-notified Tribe or Nomadic Tribe may profess any religion.

(ix) Authorities competent to verify the caste.—

The following authorities will now be competent to verify the caste of person who is a resident of State of Haryana :-

Sr. No	Category of Resident	Verifying Authority
1.	A resident of any Rural area in the State	Designated Officers notified by Citizen Resources Information Department
2.	A resident of any Urban area in the State (Municipal Committee / Municipal Council/ Municipal Corporation)	Designated Officers notified by Citizen Resources Information Department
3.	A male employee (including his children) serving on regular basis in connection with the affairs of the State of Haryana in any Department/ PSU / Statutory Authority/ University, etc.	As per record available in Human Resource Management System (HRMS)
4	A female employee serving on regular basis in connection with the affairs of the State of Haryana in any Department/ PSU/ Statutory Authority/ University, etc.	As per record available in Human Resource Management System (HRMS)

Government has also decided that in case of issuance of wrong caste certificate carelessly or deliberately without proper care or verification, action would be taken against the concerned official/s under the relevant provisions of the Indian Penal Code in addition to the action under the appropriate disciplinary rules applicable to them.

(x) Online Service for verification of Caste based on PPN.—

Residents seeking to verify their caste in PPN may visit <https://meraparivar.haryana.gov.in/ReportGrievance> portal. Once the request for verification of caste category and/or caste is made by the resident on this portal, designated officers will verify and mark the same as verified in the FIDR for the resident.

(xi) Clarification in case of doubt.—

In case of any doubt regarding caste/tribe of a person, the matter will be referred to the Welfare of Scheduled Castes and Backward Classes Department of the State of Haryana, and the clarifications given by the said Department alone shall be valid.

(xii) Competent Authorities for Issuance of Caste Certificate.—

Caste certificates shall be issued on provision of PPN through SARAL portal <https://saralharyana.gov.in/> to eligible residents of Haryana by ADC-cum-DCRIO (Additional Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Citizen Resources Information Officer) through his facsimile signature on the certificate and to the employees of the State of Haryana by the Head of the Department/Organization concerned through his facsimile signature on the certificate.

(xiii) Validity of a Caste Certificate.—

- (i) A Caste Certificate once issued (in its standard format) shall be valid for the life-time of the person so long as such caste/tribe is not removed or modified in the notifications issued by the Welfare of Scheduled Castes and Backward Classes Department, Haryana.
- (ii) Where a Caste Certificate is requested for specific use outside the context of Government of Haryana, it shall be issued in the format prescribed by the Government of India.
- (iii) Certificates which include income and/or assets based information like creamy layer criteria shall become invalid after the validity period prescribed on the said certificate. Such certificates shall be valid for the current financial year, i.e. till coming 31st March (Included) from the date it has been issued.
- (iv) A Caste Certificate may also become invalid if after due process, it has been concluded that the caste was incorrectly mentioned on the certificate or wrongly verified in the FIDR, due to any reason whatsoever.

(xiv) Grievance Redressal and Correction Process.—

If an applicant is not in agreement with his caste category/caste contained in the FIDR, then he/she may lodge his/her grievance for correction on the Grievance Module of the Parivar Pehchan Number portal <https://meraparivar.haryana.gov.in/ReportGrievance>.

(xv) General Terms and Conditions.—

- (a) The Caste Certificate is usable without any restriction wherever it is accepted (i.e., subject to the criteria laid down by the entity accepting the certificate) and hence no usage/applicability restrictions shall be mentioned on the certificate.
- (b) From the effective date of this order, only the caste certificates issued through SARAL portal in the formats prescribed by the Citizen Resources Information


Department based on PPN and corresponding verified data contained in the FIDR shall be valid caste certificates.

- (c) A Caste Certificate obtained by means of any fraud, misrepresentation or concealment of facts or by some other illegal means shall be declared as invalid and the benefit availed by the candidate/applicant shall be withdrawn and legal action including criminal case will be initiated against the applicant for misrepresenting the facts and playing fraud, as well as against the officials/authorized persons for incorrect/ wrong verification by collusion or otherwise. In such an event, the caste and caste category shall be marked as NOT VERIFIED in the FIDR.
- (d) Mere issuance of a Caste certificate does not entitle a person holding such certificate to any benefit that may be admissible under various Government Schemes implemented from time to time. Hence, it is important that the authority concerned examines the applicant's entitlement to any specific benefit in accordance with the instructions on the subject at any given point of time. For instance, a person from the Backward Class may not be entitled to certain benefits if he falls within the creamy layer as defined from time to time. Accordingly, the Caste Certificates shall address ONLY the caste of the certificate holder. Other eligibility criteria for a particular scheme shall be addressed separately by the authority extending any such benefit.
- (e) All Haryana Government organisations (including Departments, Educational Institutions, Boards, Corporations and Societies) are required to accept the Caste Certificate in its standard format prescribed by the Citizen Resources Information Department from time to time.

4. Further, it is directed that no Government Department of Haryana shall obligate any Haryana resident to submit caste related proof documents if he/she provides PPN and his/her caste and caste category is marked as verified in Family Information Data Repository (FIDR).

5. These instructions/guidelines may kindly be brought to the notice of all the concerned for strict compliance.




