Subject - Statistics for Economists

Jan - Types of data & statistical analysis procedure: - Univariate, bivariate & multivariate; census & Sampling, Basic Concepts of Sampling, Techniques of Sampling: Sampling Probability & Non-Probability Sampling: Errors: - Types & Potential Causes Sample Size, Approaches to Sample Size determination: Precision Rate & Confidence Interval.

Feb - Estimation: - Concept of an estimator & its Sampling distribution. Desirable properties of a good point estimator. Point Estimation methods: Least Squares Estimation, maximum Likelihood Estimation, method of Moments, Interval Estimation. Confidence Intervals; factors affecting the width of Confidence Intervals.

March - Introduction to Hypothesis Testing: - Basic Concepts, Null & Alternative Hypothesis, Type I & Type II errors, Significance level & P-values, critical Regions, steps involved in Hypothesis testing, Negman-Pearson Lemma. Common parametric Tests: Z-test, t-test, F-test & ANOVA

April - Introduction to non-parametric Tests & their advantages. Common Non-Parametric Tests: chi-Square test, Mann-Whitney U test, Wilcoxon Signed-rank test, Kruskal Wallis test, Friedman Test, Kendall's Tau Test, choosing between parametric & non-parametric tests based on data characteristics.
